

# GETAWAY OUTDOORS

## LOCAL FISHING REPORT



### METRO REGION - 15th March 2017

#### OFFSHORE

Pelagic action is still going strong out at the fads with reports of Blue Marlin, Mahi Mahi , Wahoo and Tuna.

Cockburn Sound is firing for King George Whiting, Snapper, Herring and Gardies. There is also plenty of Squid being caught on the weed beds.

Ocean Reef and Hillarys Boat ramps have proved a good launching platform for Dhufish and Snapper catches in 30+ metres and Sand Whiting are plentiful closer to shore for small boat anglers and are of good sizes.

There is plenty of Herring and Gardies around responding to burley as well as Samsonfish also responding to burley on lumps.

#### SHORE BASED

Woodmans Point and the Ammo jetty are still the best bet for chasing Mackerel. Herring and gardies have also been plentiful around the area.

The North Mole has had Herring, Gardies, Skippy and Blue Mackerel during the day and Tailor of an evening. The stretch between Cottesloe to Floreat is the best bet for decent sized Tailor both in the mornings on the reefs and evenings on the seabreeze. The bigger sizes have come through later in the evenings.

Pinnaroo Point has been a very good spot for both Herring and good sized Yellowfin Whiting early in the morning. Most rockwalls in those areas have also produced good numbers of herring and Gardies.

Small Mulloway were landed at Yanchep earlier in the week just north of the lagoon.

#### RIVER

Bream reports have come upstream from Maylands in the Swan but lures and baits are being smashed by very small enthusiastic fish.

Mulloway have been caught in the deep holes at Mosman Bay and towards the lower reaches.

Flathead and Flounder are still being caught on the flats around the lower reaches as far up as Point Walter but are becoming a little harder to find.
