LOCAL FISHING REPORT



GERALDTON REGION

18th May 2017

OFFSHORE

South west Bank has been producing the goods as of late with consistent reports of dhufish to 8kg and pink snapper to 5kg. Metal jigs and soft plastics have often out fished baits whilst some crafty anglers have been hedging their bets by sweetening their artificial with a strip of either squid or octopus.

Pensioner's bank has been productive with an assortment of dhufish to 5kg, coral trout, blue lined emperor and pink snapper around the 50cm mark.

Coral trout are being reported out from Drummond's cove in and around the 20mtr mark along with a few large mulloway to 13kg.

African reef has thrown up the usual suspects recently with dhufish, coral trout, baldchin groper and a few breaksea cod amongst the catches.

LAND BASED

Mulloway are still featuring heavily throughout the mid west with captures ranging from Westbank right through to Coronation beach. The 'Lives' has been one of the better locations recently with anglers reporting several captures of larger fish in excess of 12kg.

Spanish mackerel are about north of town with reports of fish busting up just offshore between Lucky Bay and Wagoie, one angler had a nice surprise landing a fish of approx 8kg whilst fishing for tailor just south of here .

Yellowfin whiting are still being found in reasonable numbers with fish between 30 -35cm reported from Pages beach, Explosives, Pt Moore and Drummond's cove.

The local rock walls are providing good mixed bags of herring, whiting and squid with most fish holding close to the rocks as larger predators such as mulloway cruise the outside edge looking for an easy feed.
